Grant Research and Development

- Researches and identifies new funding prospects that match MCC priorities including private, foundation and government opportunities.
- Stay informed about current trends and emerging opportunities in grant funding.
- Manage MCC's proposal development calendar.

#### **Grant Proposal Development**

- Collaborate with the Director of Development and Program Leaders to gather necessary information to develop high quality proposals.
- Develop compelling grant proposals in support of MCC's programs that focus on food security, older adult health and wellness, community violence intervention, youth development, housing and community engagement.
- Coordinates and follows-up on the progress of submitted proposals.

• Coordinates with the Director of Finance to complete expenditure reports and budgets for grant proposals.

#### Grant Compliance Management

- Develop and implement monitoring system to track grant performance, gather data, and compile reports.
- Ensure compliance with grant requirements.
- Collaborate with Program Leaders to gather needed information to complete grant reports.
